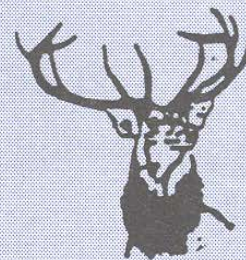

Hoops for the Hungry

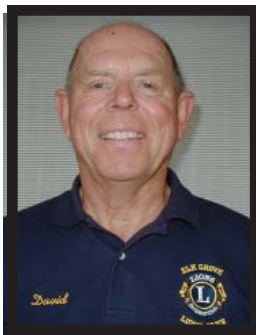

This thought provoking topic provided our youth contestants, the opportunity to delve into the many facets of the electronic age we live in today. While the Internet has provided us with a tool to help us in our everyday living, we need to asses its future impact on our lives.

This is a fantastic opportunity to express their views, build their self-esteem and open doors for financial scholarships made possible through the contest.

The contest is supported by the Lions, Lioness, and Leos of MD-4 by contribution made to the Student Speakers Foundation, Inc. which is the source of our scholarship funds. The purpose of the Foundation is to provide scholarships to augment the prizes awarded to the winners of the California-Nevada, Multiple District Four Student Speakers Program. This year the Foundation will provide scholarships totaling \$100,000.00. From this amount, each of the sixteen District winners will receive a \$4,000.00 scholarship, each of the four Area winners will receive an additional \$6,500.00 scholarship and the winner of the Multiple District Four Contest will receive an additional \$10,000.00 scholarship.

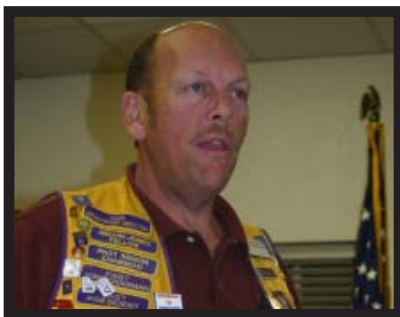
