Last night we had our Lions Christmas dinner with Santa in attendance sharing the good cheer with three excited youngsters, ho, ho, ho...!

At the end of the month we will have completed six (6) months of our current year. We have assisted in many events thus far and have many more important ones on the horizon. The Elk Grove Lions have contributed roughly 2650



hours and taken on some 37 events...! Conservatively these efforts have been responsible for more that \$50,000, in funds raised. Hopefully we will continue with the support and have a renewed enthusiasm toward helping those that we find in need with additional members joining in the festivities.

We will also be helping at the Wellsprings Women's facility coordinating eye exams and providing glasses for many. This is a joint effort with several lions Clubs in the area.

The Elk Grove Lions Foundation is now in full operation as we received two letters this past week. One, from the IRS with full 501c3 status and second, from LCI giving us authorization to use logo and name for our operational needs. We will be developing letter head and marketing materials in the coming month and if you are interested in helping please let me know. As a tax-deductible organization we will be able to receive donations from a wide variety of sources such as Trusts, other foundations, corporations and more. This is an exciting opportunity we need to value and exercise to the fullest.
