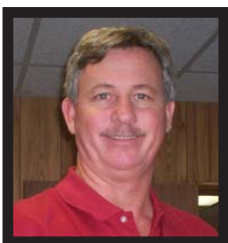




## Thanks for a fantastic year!

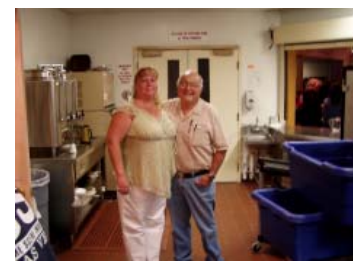

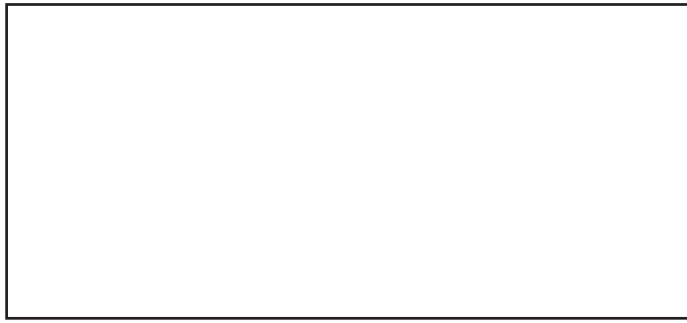
