The events came off just fine. We cooked for around 350 students at each school. The Sheldon event was held at the Baptist Church and the EG High breakfast was at the school. The following Lions, *Heinz Leonhardt, Bill Hibbard, Bill Heston, Bob Brewer, Club President Andy Anderson, Brad Dano, DG Gary Dapelo, Jerry Salamy, Vincent Vernon, Dave King, Sterling Kloss, Dan Pearson, John Zender, and Pancho Sanchez* stepped up and the effort came off in fine fashion.

This year was interesting as none of the Lions involved have any children attending the schools, with the exception of Lion Zender, who at last count still has about 47 of his relatives attending or teaching at our local schools. This also is the first graduating class that had not actually seen Lion Hibbard's "Beer Face". Although Lion Bill was requested to "perform" his natural shyness prevented him from sharing this experience with the seniors. How in the world will these students be prepared for college without that experience under their belts?

As one of the last events for the current year, the double duty cost the club less than \$500.00, with a donation forth coming from the Sheldon Senior Class. Costing the club only a couple of hundred dollars to feed around 700 students shows how the Elk Grove Lions perform to benefit our community. The pre-mentioned donation reflects how much the effort was appreciated.

Sacramento County Fair May 22 - 26

This year we received a total of 108 letters from eight FFA Chapters and six 4H groups. The letters were for 24 small and 84 large animals.

Throughout the course of the year we raised \$9,558.54 to spend for this year's county fair. We spent \$1,124.50 on awards and \$8,140.93 on animals and add-ons. Total expenses were \$9,265.42. This leaves us a balance of \$293.11 to start next year's FFA/4H Project Account. We were able to purchase 28 animals during the sell and added 14 add-ons.

Chickens – 5 Elk Grove HS - 6 Turkeys - 4 Sheldon HS - 8 Rabbits – 5 Florin HS - 5

Goats - 4 Pleasant Grove HS - 2

Lambs - 2Franklin HS - 3 Hogs-7Delta HS - 1 Steers – 1 Franklin 4H - 1 Wilton 4H-2


