Five Minutes with an Elk Grove Lion Lion Jim Parino



LION DANIEL M. (DANNY) DIBENEDETTO

Danny has served twice president of the Elk Grove Lions Club and instrumental in the construction of Strauss Island and the Youth Center in Elk Grove Regional Park. Danny served as president in 1986-87, and again in 1994-95, and has been awarded the *Melvin Jones* Fellow, the highest award the organization can give, for his dedicated humanitarian services. He has also received the **Gordon Daniels Associate Member** of the Northern California Lions Sight Association for outstanding club leadership and service. And recently was presented a "LIONS LIFE MEMBERSHIP"

Incoming Lion president Dave King said, "When we Lions think of Danny, he was our 'Godfather,' a patriarch of the club just as he was for his family. He was very dedicated to the Elk Grove community and expressed his dedication through his commitment to the Elk Grove Lions."

A year ago Lion Danny had the pleasure of seeing his grandson, Daniel DiBenedetto III installed as club president. Lion Danny was born Sept. 28, 1926 in Quincy, Mass., the youngest of eight children and the only boy as a brother died in infancy. He served in World War II from 1944 to 1946 as a machinist mate 2nd class in the U.S. Navy and was in the Philippines.



In 1947 he married *Grace Mazzola*, and in 1952 the family came to California with \$250 in their pockets. He was a baker for Daisy Baking Co., then worked for Robert Plumbing, and then started his own plumbing company, running it for 36 years before retiring.

Community activities included Sons In Retirement, Elk Grove Elks Lodge, VFW and Italian Club of Piemonte Real of Sacramento. He is survived by his wife of 63 years, Grace DiBenedetto; son David DiBenedetto and wife Sherry; grandchildren Buffy Holt and husband Craig, Daniel DiBenedetto III and wife Sunni,

Andy DiBenedetto, Tony DiBenedetto and Crystal DiBenedetto; daughter-in-law Diane DiBenedetto and eight great-grandchildren, all living in the Elk Grove area.
