Committee Reports:

- 1. Lion David Ogden reported that the installation of officers will be at Vince's Restaurant on June 27th with PDG Martin Kennison doing the Installing.
- 2. Annual Wine & Food Tasting event will be on July 8. Great concern voiced over the status of the event since the chairman, Lion Tim Watts, was not available to report on the progress.

- Beer Booth Chairman Lion Jim Parino reported that the license has been obtained and the beer has been ordered. Security will cost \$18 per hour during serving times.

Relay for Life scheduled for May 21/22 Lion **Don Thompson** reported that it will require a great deal of hands on labor for Lions members. There will be additional volunteer help available for bussing. serving and maintaining serving tables but the three meals will require lots of cooks to feed nearly 1000 people each meal.
